Marriages: Engaged couples must contact the priest 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

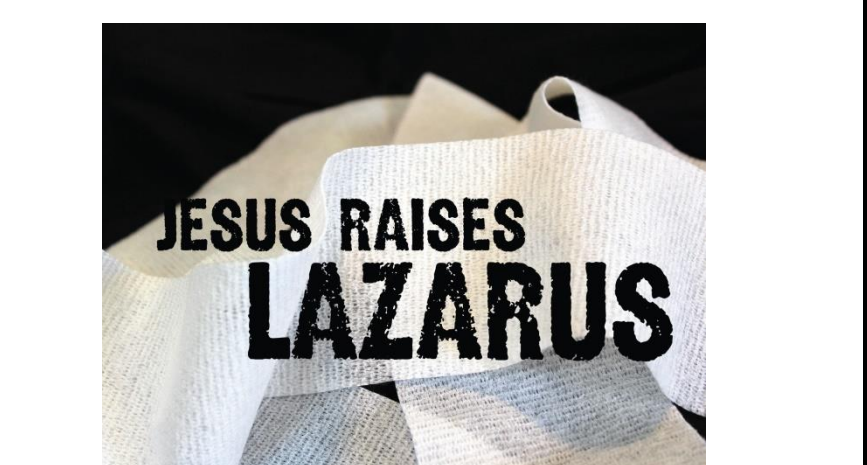

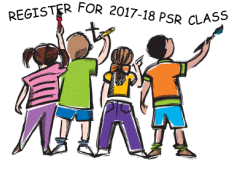

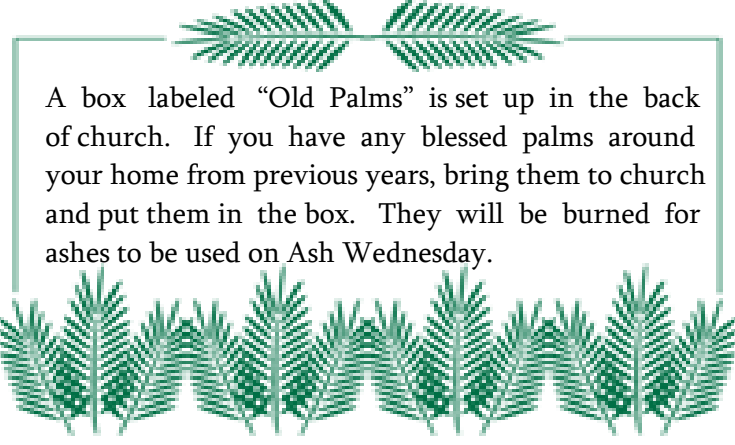

FRIDAY, APRIL 14, 2017

You are invited to a day long (6:00 AM-3:00 PM) Pilgrimage Way of the Cross. The journey is one of prayer, reflection, silence and meditation on the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ. ****Please note the route and times have changed.****

We will assemble at Holy Rosary beginning at 6:00 AM so we can eat breakfast, and start the 1st station in Church at 7:00 AM sharp. You can leave your vehicle at Church. We will walk to St. Anne (lunch), then back to Holy Rosary. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Lunch, drinks and refreshments will be provided. Please bring your rosary.
