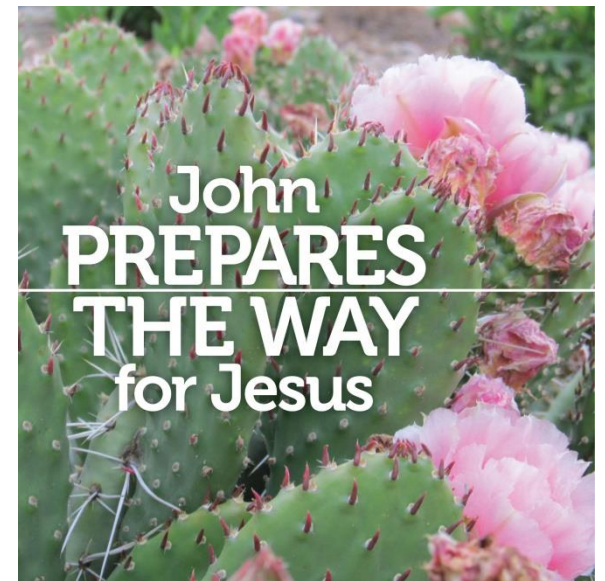

Special Collection for St. Joseph Seminary College

St. Joseph Abbey and Seminary College in Covington, LA, have had a profound influence on the life of the Catholic Church in the Deep South. For over 125 years the monks of the abbey have been educating and forming young men as candidates for the priesthood. Most of our own diocesan priests have studied there.

In August 2016, a disastrous flood overwhelmed the Abbey & Seminary. The library lost many of its treasured volumes. The ground floor of the monastery sustained significant damage. In all, 30 buildings on the campus received at least 2 feet of water. In order for the monks of the abbey to continue their mission, they will need the generous help of the people of the Dioceses of Louisiana.
