Seminars are held as needed on the 1st Tuesday of the *even numbered* months and are required for parents and godparents. Parents should contact the Parish office in the first trimester of pregnancy to receive a Baptismal Packet.

Marriages: Engaged couples must contact the priest 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

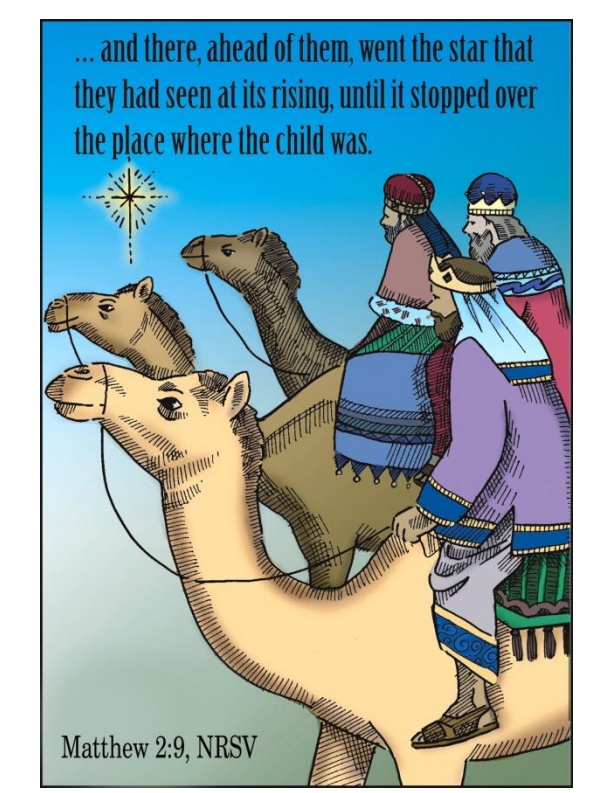
