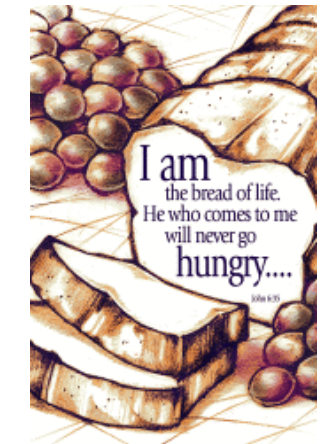

Welcome to the 2021-2022 St. Anne/St. Anthony Parish School of Religion (PSR) Program!

On Sunday, August 29, 2021, our PSR Program will begin in-person classes. Grades 1-6 will meet from 8:30am-10:15am; Grades 7 & 8 will meet from 11:30am-1:00pm; Grade 9 and Confirmation Prep (Grades 10 & 11) will meet once a month from 11:30am-1:00pm. A complete schedule, along with more specific information, will be emailed to you in the near future.

Please note: If you are not comfortable sending your child to in-person classes, you have the option to teach your student using our At Home Faith Learning Program. If you would like to utilize this program, please reply via email or call/text Anne Miller as soon as possible so that plans can be made for our PSR year.

- For PSR in-person classes and activities:
 - Wearing face coverings/masks will be optional.
 - Each family will be asked to sign a health questionnaire/waiver prior to the start of PSR. This includes an agreement that you will keep your student(s) at home if they are experiencing certain health-related symptoms.
 - Sanitization of the activity center and classrooms will occur after usage.
 - Safety guidelines provided by our diocese will be followed to ensure everyone's safety.
- *Decisions regarding in-person classes, the wearing of face coverings/masks, etc. are subject to change at any time.*
