

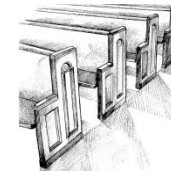

HYBRID SEATING & MASK MANDATE

With much thought and discussion, and due to increased mass participation, a decision has been made to open more pews at both St. Anne and St. Anthony. Beginning the weekend of May 8/9, half of ALL pews will be opened at each church. Facing the altar, the left hand side of each church (and the balcony at St. Anthony) will no longer have every-other pew blocked off.

If you prefer to continue with social distancing during mass, we are asking you to be seated on the right hand side, where pews will continue to be blocked and social distancing will be maintained.
