Seminars are held as needed on the 1st Tuesday of the even numbered months and are required for parents and godparents. Parents should contact the Parish office in the first trimester of pregnancy to receive a Baptismal Packet.

Marriages: Engaged couples must contact the priest 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

Deaths: The family must make arrangements with the parish office before contacting the funeral home.

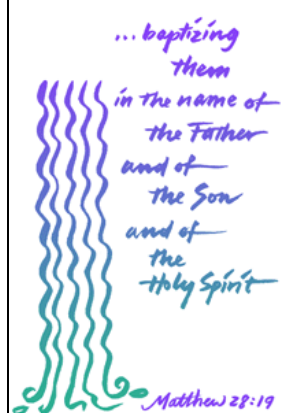

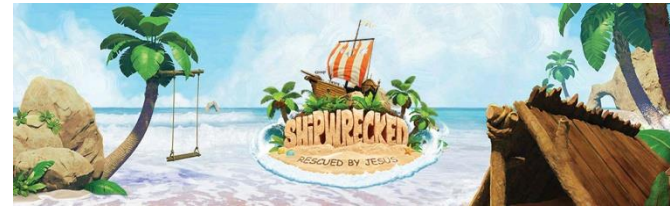

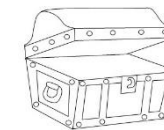
