An organization called SOAR (Support Our Aging Religious) has been soliciting donations from our parishes and other institutions and causing confusion since they are supposedly serving the same groups as National Religious Retirement Collection.

This is not an operation affiliated in any way with the National Religious Retirement Collection or USCCB and I would urge extreme caution in promoting their collection and in making donations to them.

The Religious Retirement Collection, scheduled for December 11, is the only collection supported by the USCCB and the Diocese of Baton Rouge to assist aged religious. Donations to other organizations transfers control of the funds outside of the established controls at USCCB and will have the effect of causing confusion to our parishioners and among the religious orders. While not a fraudulent organization, it does cause confusion and should not be supported.

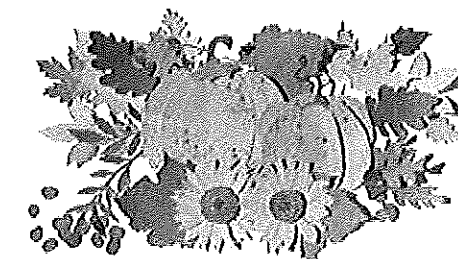

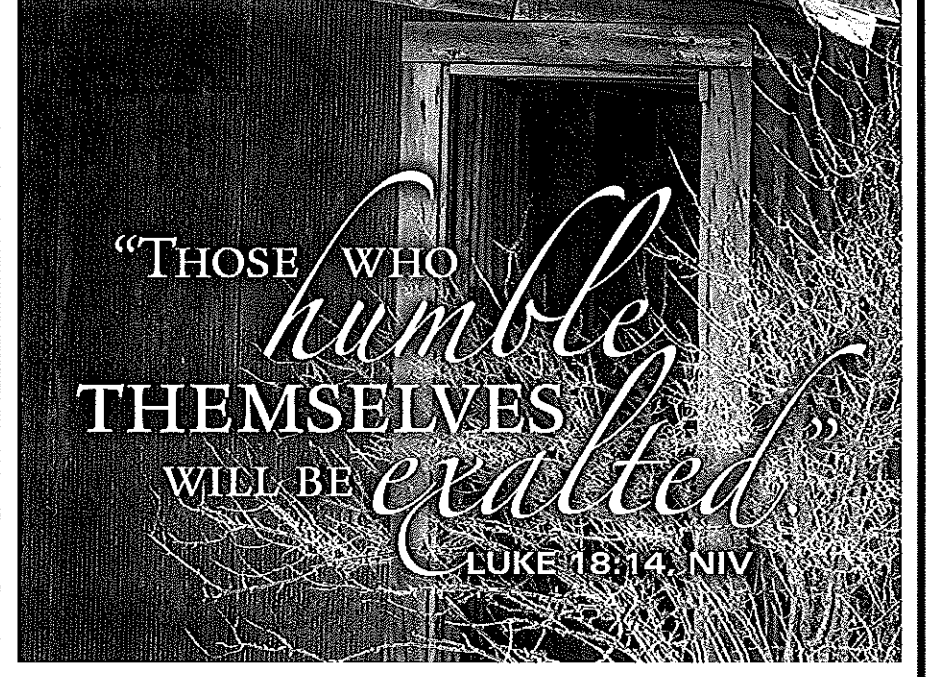
