Marriages: Engaged couples must contact the priest 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

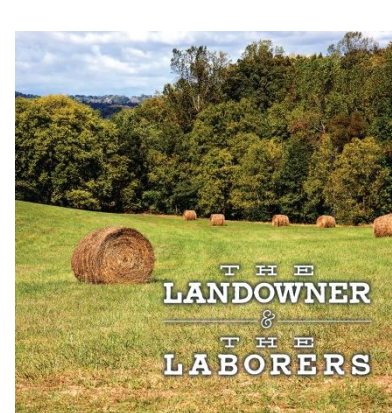

Deaths: The family must come into the office to make arrangements before making arrangements with the funeral home.

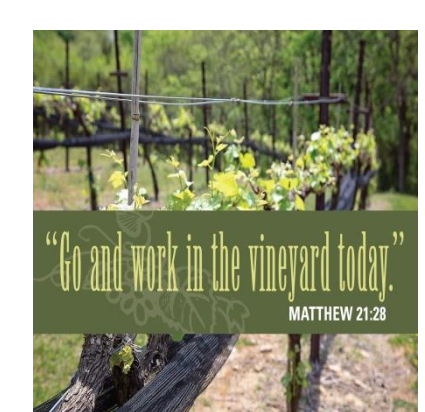
