Marriages: Engaged couples must contact the priest 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

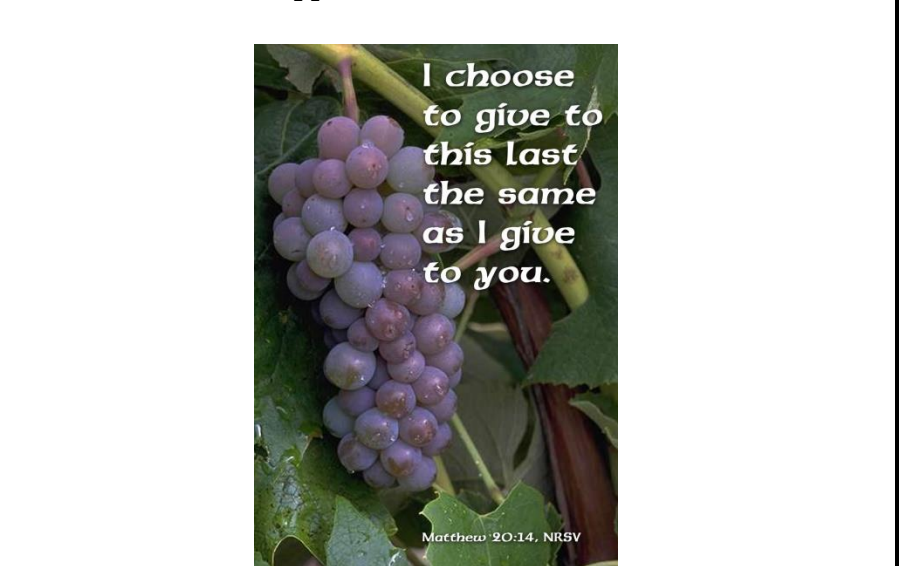
