Please see attached flyers for additional information. Raising Cane's River Center is offering **special discounted group rates for ten or more to the diocese**. The group rate is \$12.50 per ticket and there are no fees per ticket. The only additional charge is a one-time \$10 processing charge on the entire order. The hours for the exhibit are M-W from 10 AM – 5:30 PM, Thurs.-Fri. from 10 AM – 8 PM, Saturday from 10 AM – 5PM, and Sunday from 12 PM – 5 PM. They suggest about an hour and a half for the exhibit however it is completely up to you how much time you would like to spend. It is recommended no more than 120 patrons in a group at a time. In addition, they have some exclusive group discounts available for nearby museums the USS Kidd and the Louisiana Arts and Science Museum.
